ORDINANCE 2018-108

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KENEFICK, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE CURRENT FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP(S); PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kenefick, Texas, ("City") finds that adopting the current Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) is for the health, safety, and general welfare of the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KENEFICK, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations found in the preamble to this Ordinance are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City of Kenefick, Texas, adopts the current Flood Insurance Rate Map(s).

Section 3. The City declares that each new Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) shall be automatically adopted without further action by the City.

Section 4. Severability.

In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the city council of the City of Kenefick, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.

Section 5. Repeal.

All ordinance or pats of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and is hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
